

## Old Business:

## Mutual Aid and Joint Powers Agreement Review:

Open discussion: Jennifer from Olmsted County Attorney's Office provided a document for review. This document's purpose is to exercise powers jointly.

- 1. Send a copy of the by-laws
- 2. Open Meeting Law- send annual meeting notice to post on each county website, keep an audit of all counties and how they are posting it. This does have criminal implications on the person if not met.
- 3. Fiscal Agent language- Jennifer recommended not passing the checks on to multiple people, it is a liability.
  - a. Is there a contract with LeSueur County documenting the fiscal agent role? If there is a document, then it should be reviewed. Rich commented in 2015 it took a year and a half for each county to review and approve the agreement.



- b. By-laws update to not elect the fiscal agent each year, need a contract. Everyone should have access to the governing documents and secure information. Get the website up to date, bring to next meeting.
- c. Jennifer recommended the fiscal agent should be applying for the grants and not the president.
- d. Recommend moving the by-laws language article 6, section 4 be moved or copied to the JPB agreement.
- 4. Do we have insurance? No, the camera trailers are put on the county insurance of the housing jurisdiction. Add a rider when using. Jennifer will review and provide feedback on the agreement language, business, or legal rationale.
- 5. Titles of the trailers need to be inventoried and gathered. The JPB couldn't own equipment.
- 6. Section 7.2.5 never has had legal counsel or contracted attorney. Jennifer doesn't see a contract as necessary. Rich commented in the past it fell on the county who the Chair is. Jennifer said we could consider an attorney as a member of the JPB.
- 7. Insurance for individual board members would reside through the county they represent.
- 8. Section 11.3 The property section could be more robust with additional language.
- 9. Section 12.2 agreement automatically renews unless something happens.
- 10. Section 10 last paragraph when the county board changes, bring it back for review and every 5 years we will bring it back to the county board. Rich is hesitant to change language since it took so long the last time to review.

Next step, Kristen will send notes to Jennifer. Jennifer will make changes and then will send to the group for each county to review.
